

Let the World In! Big Learning Foreign Language: FLES



Fall Session begins September 19, 2016

Winter Session begins January 17, 2017

Introductory Level (12 or 24-week sessions)

Children begin to learn a new language through interactive storytelling, hands-on activities and role play with puppets and props. We'll play fun games, sing songs, learn greetings and classroom routines and practice new vocabulary and expressions - all in another language. Sessions feature two favorite stories. Three Little Pigs, Fall 2016 and the Little Red Riding Hood, Winter 2017!

(Grades K-1)

Beginner Level (12 or 24-week sessions)

Learn a new language in an informal setting! Our fun, imaginative games and activities spark verbal interactions and allow children to practice speaking in pairs and small groups. Creative workbooks support early reading and writing skills in the new language. Favorite topics through the year include the birthday party, pets, sports, breakfast foods, family, farm animals, and more. Language teachers from around the globe share songs, stories and cultural notes for a foreign language experience that lasts a lifetime.

(Grades 2-5 or 3-6; no prerequisite)

Intermediate Level (24-week session)

Children begin to express themselves with expanding confidence! We'll review and build on Beginner Level concepts, vocabulary and expressions and learn new vocabulary from topics such as telling time, wild animals, prepositions, lunch and snacks, setting the table and tongue twisters! Favorite activities include writing and presenting an autobiography, designing and describing a "dream room" and acting out a restaurant visit. Children make progress in reading and writing with creative workbooks and challenging games.

(Grades 3-6 with Beginner experience)

Advanced Level (24-week session)

Now we're going somewhere! Advanced Level lessons focus on reading and writing in addition to speaking and comprehension. Favorite topics include transportation, clothing, shopping, community, professions, directions, geography and more! With an imaginary suitcase and new vocabulary, children plan a trip, design community maps and practice navigating and exploring their world with their classmates. The year culminates with a writing project, cultural event or visit to a local embassy.

(Grades 4-6 with Intermediate experience)

World Culture (4-week mini session)

Taught in English, this creative program introduces children to aspects of culture and traditions from four continents - Africa, Asia, South America and Europe - through music, games and hands-on activities to take home. (grades 2-5 or 3-6)
